Nibley Green is a half a mile from the beautiful little village of North Nibley and was the perfect setting for our bank holiday weekend family getaway.



he house sleeps up to ten people across four en-suite spacious bedrooms with space for an additional two cots, dogs are also permitted at an extra cost. The beds were extremely comfortable and the facilities clean and tidy.

After our journey it was a lovely surprise to be greeted with a selection of delicious cakes and pastries and some fresh milk. The kitchen was modern and contained everything you would need for a cosy weekend away.

The living room was spacious and included a large selection of DVDs and games, which kept us entertained for hours when we were not out and about exploring the stunning countryside. The front garden was huge with a stunning lawn, flowerbeds, plants and trees which made the perfect spot to grab some well earned relaxation.
